

Heaven scent

An old gift in new bottles? Not these up-to-the-minute fragrances for men and women.

Acqua di Biella, famous for its eau de toilette made with 18th-century recipes, was founded in 1871. Its latest fragrance, Bursch, is made with a blend of bergamot, incense, pimento, coriander, cedar, vetiver and oakmoss.

Nearly 80 years after the launch of *Arpège*, Lanvin has created a masculine version with a woody Oriental scent that makes reference to the original perfume with notes of iris and jasmine. The clean-cut square bottle's black circle also recalls the round shape of the women's flacon.

The recently introduced *Very Irrésistible Givenchy for Men* fragrance has top notes of mint leaf and grapefruit zest, middle notes of sesame seed and mocha, and base notes of hazel wood and cedar.

Moschino Friends Men, from the house founded by the iconoclastic Italian fashion designer, is a fresh citrus fragrance created by perfumer Olivier Polge.

In its plum and violet bottle shaped like an old-fashioned whiskey flask, *Tumulte pour Homme*, the men's version of couture designer Christian Lacroix's latest fragrance, has many notes including juniper and laurel, balsam, Somali incense and varieties of cedar.

A blend of spicy and woody notes in *Lacoste's Essential* conveys the spirit of the sporty lifestyle represented by the brand: freedom, enjoyment, relaxation and joie de vivre.
